



VENDOR REGULATIONS

April 27 through October 6, 2024

1. Compliance with Regulations

Vendors are responsible for adhering to all market regulations, as well as local, state, and federal regulations relevant to their products.

2. Market Hours and Location

Saturdays: 8:00 AM to 12:30 PM at Flower City Park

Exceptions: No Market on June 8, August 3 and August 10.

Wednesdays: 8:00 AM to 12:30 PM at the Livestock Barns in Flower City Park

June 12 to October 16. Exceptions: No Market on July 31.

3. Set up and Tear Down

- Set up begins at 7:00 AM and must be completed before the market opens.
- Vendors must move vehicles to designated parking areas during the market.
- Tear down must be completed within an hour of market closing.
- Park must be vacated by 1:30 PM on both days.

4. Stall Fees and Insurance

No stall fees are required. Liability insurance is the responsibility of individual vendors.

5. Safety

- Canopies, tables, and produce must remain entirely on the grass behind the midway on Saturdays.
- Tripping hazards must be avoided. Canopies should be anchored securely.
- Smoking is prohibited within 200 feet of the market, and animals are not allowed within 50 feet due to health regulations.

6. Product Origin and Sales

- Items must be produced within a 100-mile radius of Palmyra, Missouri.
- Vendors selling items by weight must use approved scales.
- Vendors selling certain items require a farmers market permit from the Marion County Health Department.

7. Vendor Agreement

All vendors must sign a hold harmless agreement before setting up.

8. Market Management

- Flower City Market reserves the right to deny vendors space or ask them to leave for any appropriate reason.
- Vendors must inform themselves of and comply with all local, state, and federal requirements.
